CONFLICT OF INTEREST

School Board members and all District employees will conduct school business transactions in an open, ethical, and above-board basis that avoids even the appearance of impropriety.

School Board members and all District employees are prohibited from having either a direct or indirect interest in school related business transactions in which they have a pecuniary interest or may derive profit. All Board members and all District employees shall disclose potential conflicts as required by law. This may include business transactions that may benefit a Board member or employee's spouse or child. <u>Board members and District employees should be aware that there are some potential conflicts of interest that cannot be alleviated through disclosure.</u>

No Board member or District employee may make or approve purchases from any member of their immediate household, or from any enterprise in which they or a member of their immediate household holds an interest.
