

CONFLICT OF INTEREST

School Board members and all District employees will conduct school business transactions in an open, ethical, and above-board basis that avoids even the appearance of impropriety.

School Board members and all District employees are prohibited from having either a direct or indirect interest in school related business transactions in which they have a pecuniary interest or may derive profit. All Board members and all District employees shall disclose potential conflicts as required by law. This may include business transactions that may benefit a Board member or employee's spouse or child. Board members and District employees should be aware that there are some potential conflicts of interest that cannot be alleviated through disclosure.

No Board member or District employee may make or approve purchases from any member of their immediate household, or from any enterprise in which they or a member of their immediate household holds an interest.
