Area 31 Building Trades Program works toward completion of training facility



A second year of work has begun on a new classroom building at the Emergency Services Education Center.

Students from the Building Trades Program at Area 31 Career Center are constructing the facility on High School Road. It will be used to train emergency response workers such as firefighters.

The students are from Ben Davis High School and most of the ten other schools that send students to the Career Center. They can earn 18 credits from Ivy Tech through their work in the program.

“The building trades are in dire need of skilled workers,” said Doug Sisk, Area 31 building trades instructor. “The trades are currently suffering the loss of many baby boomers. We are receiving calls weekly about employment opportunities for our students.”

The classroom building is scheduled for completion in the spring of 2016.
