



MSD Wayne graduation rate rises to 94 percent



Indiana education officials have certified a 94-percent graduation rate for MSD Wayne for the 2013-14 school year.

“We knew this when we issued diplomas last June, but the rate isn’t official until the Indiana Department of Education certifies it many months later,” said MSD Wayne Superintendent Jeff Butts. “We’re proud of the hard work and steady improvement that has led to this accomplishment.”

This is the school district’s highest graduation rate since the state introduced a new graduation formula eight years ago.

When MSD Wayne students who need more than four years to graduate are included, the district’s graduation rate increases to 97 percent.

“We are also proud of our students who are not counted as graduates but earn alternative certificates,” said Dr. Butts. “All of these students are prepared for success in the future.”
