



## Moira Clark named IASP District 7 Elementary Principal of the Year



The Indiana Association of School Principals (IASP) has named Moira Clark, principal of Maplewood Elementary, its District 7 Elementary Principal of the Year for 2015. District 7 includes all of Marion County.

Mrs. Clark is in her sixth year as principal of Maplewood. This year, under Mrs. Clark's leadership, Maplewood was named Indiana's National Title 1 Distinguished School for closing the achievement gap for students from low-income families. With ISTEP passage rates of 72.1 percent for English/language arts and 74.4 percent for math, Maplewood was asked to share its documented methods for closing the achievement gap with other schools around the country.

Mrs. Clark is now in the running for the IASP State Elementary Principal of the Year award.

"We're very proud of what Mrs. Clark has accomplished at Maplewood," said MSD Wayne Superintendent Jeff Butts. "She has worked hard to engage students, staff, families, and the community surrounding Maplewood. That hard work has paid off in tremendous ways for our students."
