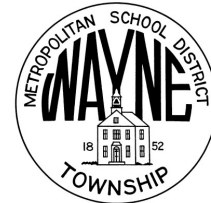

## **MSD Wayne Board of Education member honored by Indiana University**

Phyllis Lewis, secretary of the Metropolitan School District of Wayne Township Board of Education, has been named a Top 100 Alumni Legacy Leader by the Indiana University School of Nursing.
