



TV Crew from South Korea visits Ben Davis High School



A crew from the Korean Broadcasting System spent a week at Ben Davis High School in September. The crew gathered interviews and video for an upcoming documentary on the role of sports in high school.

KBS Producer Felix Kwon says the documentary will celebrate the Asian Games held this fall in Incheon, South Korea. It will also advocate for sports in South Korean education.

“Korean high school students are driven too much on education,” Kwon says. “They have very few sports and physical education hours, especially for juniors and seniors.”

Kwon and his three crew members (photographer Jaeyoung Koo is pictured above) interviewed administrators, teachers, and student athletes. Athletes they focused on included football quarterback Kyle Castner and cross-country runner Connie Brahm.

KBS is similar to the Public Broadcasting System in the United States. It has more than 50 million viewers around the world. The documentary will air later this year.
