

## **RULES OF ORDER**

School Board meetings shall be formal enough for orderly procedure but informal enough to be natural and to encourage discussion and to promote thought and action. The Board recognizes the need to adopt necessary procedures to conduct meetings effectively and efficiently.

In all procedural matters not covered by state law, State Board of Education rules or other policies adopted by the Board, the conduct of meetings shall be governed by Robert's Rule of Order, Revised.

The rules may be suspended or altered at any regular or special meeting of the Board, by a vote of a majority of all members of the Board.
