

## STUDENT RESIDENCE CHANGE

The MSD of Wayne Township School Board recognizes the need for the District to have guidelines to be followed when considering the continued enrollment of students whose legal settlement changes during the first semester of the school year. The Superintendent is directed to develop guidelines for the implementation of this Policy.

The Board considers it appropriate to use the language of the applicable Indiana Statute (I.C. 20-26-11-2(8)):

If a student's legal settlement is changed after the student has begun attending school in a school corporation in any school year, the effective date of change may, at the election of the parent, or the student if the student is at least eighteen (18) years of age, or a juvenile court conducting a proceeding under [IC 31-34-20-5](#), [IC 31-34-21-10](#), [IC 31-37-19-26](#), or [IC 31-37-20-6](#) (or [IC 31-6-4-18.5](#) before its repeal), be extended until the end of that semester, or, at the discretion of the school, until the end of that school year. However, that election, where the student has completed grade 11 in any school year, shall extend to the end of the following school year in grade 12.

This policy runs in conjunction with *Policy C250*, whereas the District may elect to extend a student's enrollment to the end of the school year, but after the end of that school year the student is considered a transfer student.
