

## STUDENT DUE PROCESS RIGHTS

The School Board of MSD of Wayne Township and Indiana statute appoint District employees with the right to take any disciplinary action necessary to promote student conduct that conforms with an orderly and effective educational system. Students must be given “due process” before they are suspended or expelled.

The Superintendent shall establish and maintain procedures that guarantee students their constitutional and statutory rights of due process protection through proper notice and meeting in all cases involving suspension and expulsion. These procedures shall be followed in all instances unless waived freely and voluntarily in writing by either the student or his/her parent.

The Board has voted to hear appeals from expulsion hearings within ten (10) calendar days of a student’s expulsion hearing.
