Indiana Code 5-14-1.5-3 (Open Door Law) provides that all meetings of the governing bodies of public agencies must be open at all times for the purposes of permitting members of the public to observe and record them. School Board meetings are held in public but are not public meetings or public forums. The Board prefers that comments be offered during the public input portion of the agenda. The Board President will recognize speakers and invite them to the microphone in the order in which they signed up. When addressing the Board, please state your name and address for the record. As a rule, the members of the Board do not respond to comments at this time. Each person's statement should not exceed two (2) minutes. Comments should be directed to the Board President. This time is reserved for Board input not for questions and answers. Comments should not reference specific employees, patrons, or students in the corporation. No attire with provocative verbiage, symbols, or images; nor any signs, will be permitted. Board President may excuse a person who is simply repeating what has already been said, is abusive, or is rude.
