# Home Schools


- ❑ Students will still “belong” to their home school
- ❑ All requirements for enrollment, residency, vaccinations remain the same
- ❑ Nurses will still be gathering and entering vaccination data into CHIRP(Children and Hoosier Immunization Registry Program) and deadlines remain the same
- ❑ Will provide for a smooth transition if/when students return to Brick and Mortar School

# Instructional Design and Curriculum

- ❑ Engaged in synchronous and asynchronous learning
- ❑ Students engaged in 5 hours of instructional time, daily
  - ❑ 8:30 am - 3:00 pm
  - ❑ Morning: core content - reading, writing, math
  - ❑ Afternoon: writing conferences, small group instruction, science/social studies, student supports, assessments, and special area
- ❑ Maintain curricular pace, scope and sequence
  - ❑ Aligned with home school to allow for mobility
- ❑ Maintain expectations for assessing and grading
