Home Schools

- Students will still "belong" to their home school
- All requirements for enrollment, residency, vaccinations remain the same
- Nurses will still be gathering and entering vaccination data into CHIRP(Children and Hoosier Immunization Registry Program) and deadlines remain the same

 - return to Brick and Mortar School

Instructional Design and Curriculum

- Engaged in synchronous and asynchronous learning
- Students engaged in 5 hours of instructional time, daily
 - 8:30 am 3:00 pm
 - Morning: core content reading, writing, math
 - Afternoon: writing conferences, small group instruction, science/social studies, student supports, assessments, and special area
- Maintain curricular pace, scope and sequence
 Aligned with home school to allow for mobility
