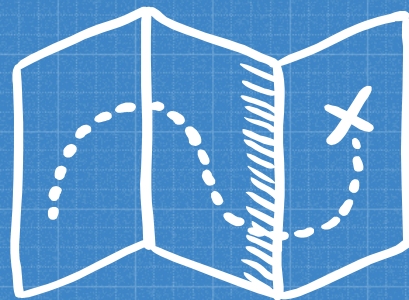

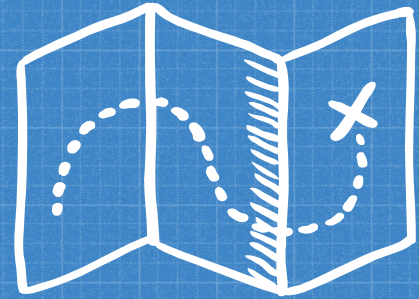

2022 Ongoing and Recently Completed Work

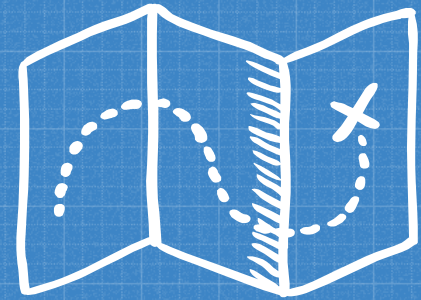
Completed projects

- Education Center 1st floor interior offices

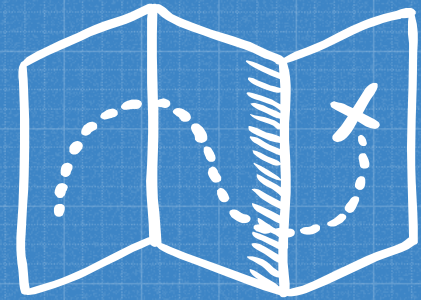


Ongoing Projects

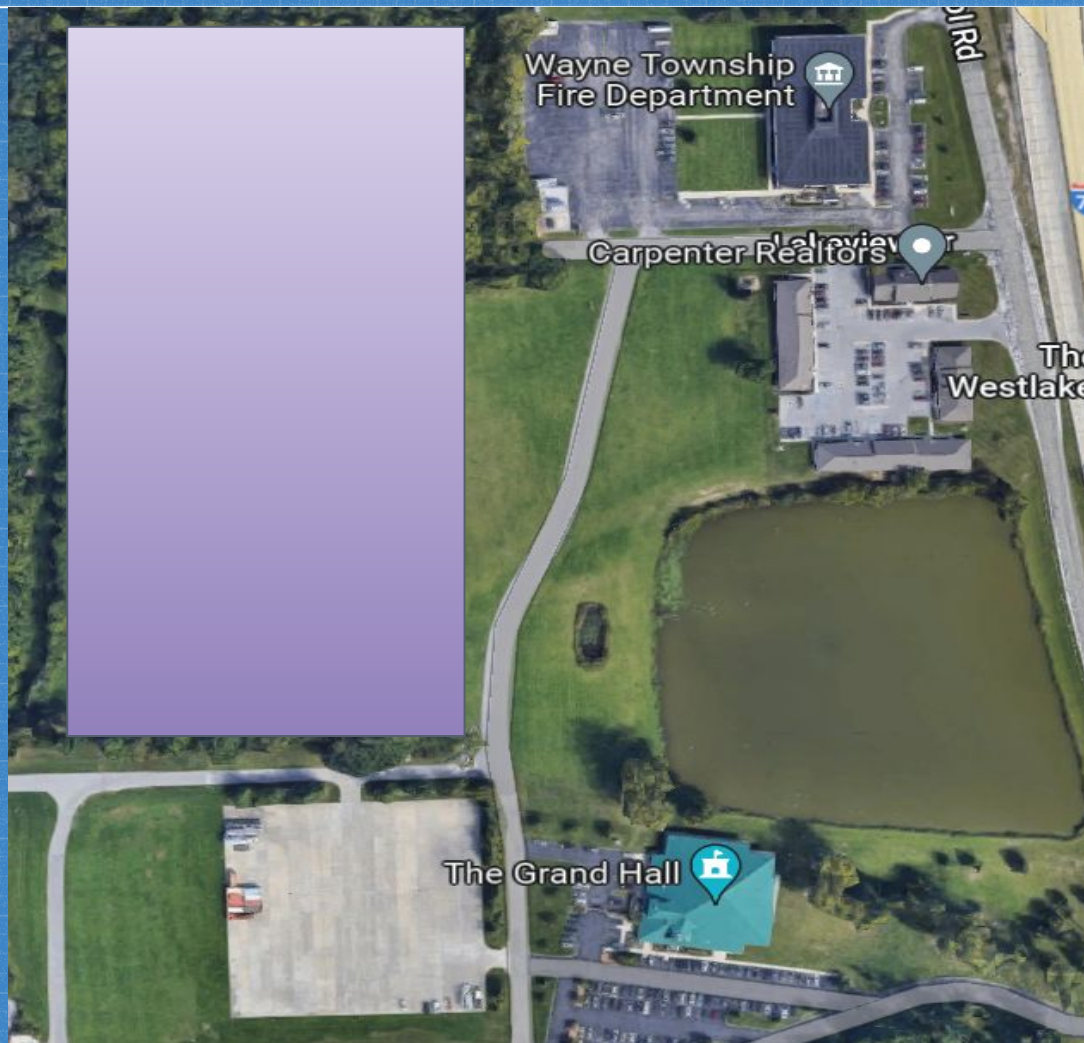

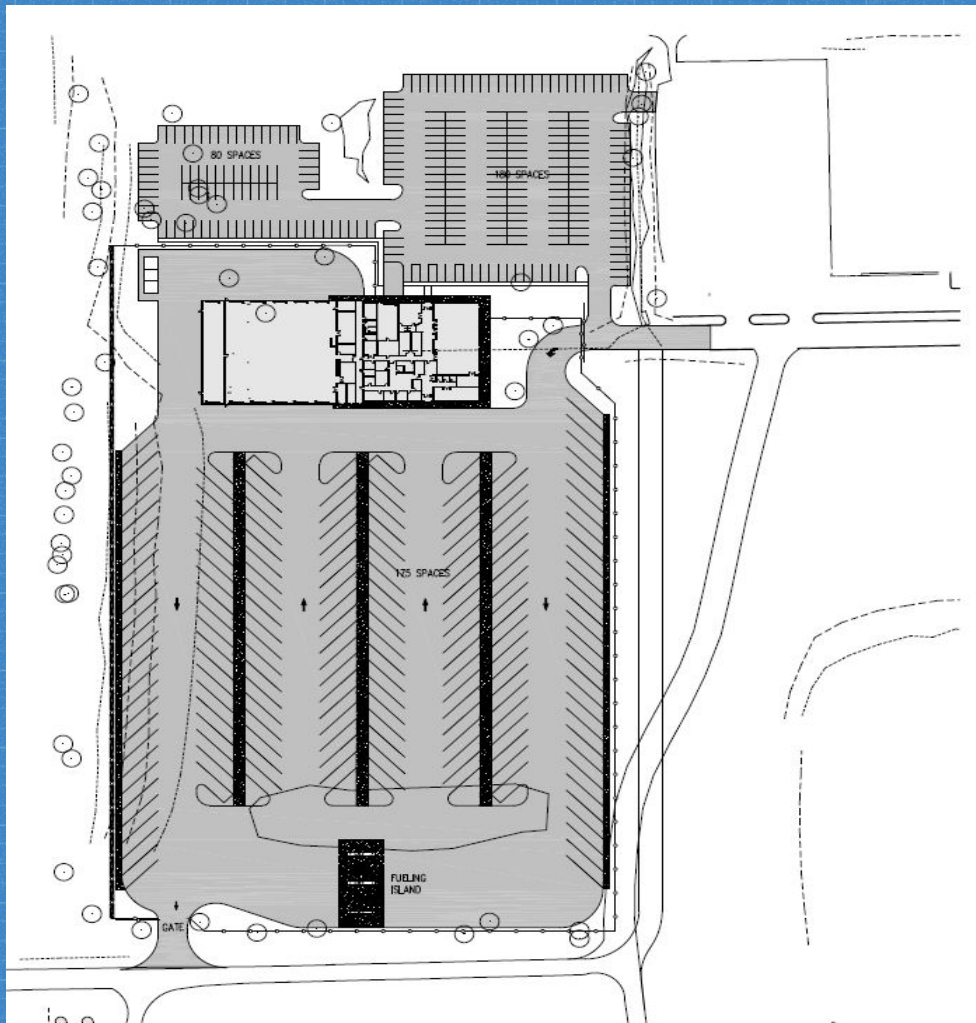

MSDWT Fire Dept HQ



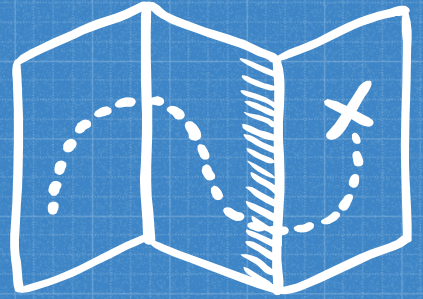
- Initial layout for the site includes additional parking for PD.
- Layout minimizes the impact to heritage trees and wetlands.



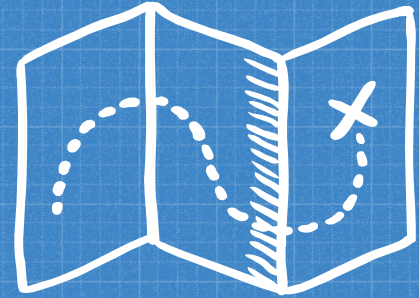

- BDHS Cafeteria / Main Entrance / Clinic



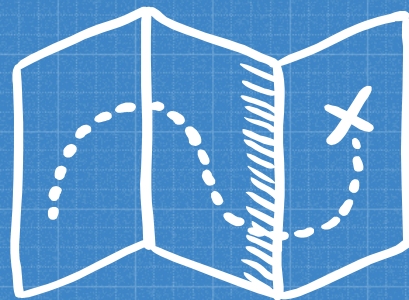

Cafeteria Expansion

Today's Topics:

1. Needs assessment surrounding lunch schedule and how this impacts instruction time in the classroom
2. Potential options for expanding the cafeteria and reconfiguring adjacent spaces
3. Summary of timeline





1 - Needs assessment

- Maximize instructional time
 - 5 lunches @ 24 mins = 120
 - 3 lunches @ 30 mins = 90

~40 additional instructional minutes
- Efficiencies for administrative supervision
- Increased accessibility for coursework in the master schedule
- Increased flexibility with scheduling

2 - Options for expanding cafeteria

- Expand the existing cafeteria east into the commons and media center.
- Build a second floor in the media center and move it upstairs to allow for more cafeteria space on the first floor.
- Reconfigure the north stair.
- Potential needed for additional space which may require moving further east into the clinic and admin areas. This will require further evaluation and planning to define the project boundaries and scope.
- Clinic and front entrance are already slated for renovations and may be wrapped into a larger project with the cafeteria expansion.

3 - Summary and Timeline

- Complete needs assessment - Q4 2022
- Initial design - Q1 2023
- Final design - Q2 2023
- Bid - Q3 2023
- Start construction Q4 2023
