

SCHOOL BOARD ELECTION

The School Board will consist of seven (7) members. Eligibility and elections of Board Members shall follow the District's Organization Plan duly adopted and filed with the State Board of Education. Members are elected on a non-partisan ballot at the November general election in even-numbered years and serve four-year terms. A Board member may serve successive terms without limitation. The term of a Board member begins on January 1 and ends on December 31. The terms of Board members are staggered so that four or three Board seats are elected every two years. A Board member may continue to serve successive terms without limitation.

Candidates for election to the Board must, at the time of their election, be registered to vote at an address within the school district, be at least twenty-one (21) years of age, and have lived in the school district for at least one year before the election. An employee of the school district or current MSD Wayne Township student may not be a member of the Board. Otherwise qualified candidates may succeed themselves in office without limitation. Property ownership shall not disqualify a person from serving as a Board member.

Before August 1st of each District school year, the Superintendent shall file with the Indiana Department of Education a list of the names and addresses of the members of the Board and the District's Officers, and the expiration of their respective terms.

The District shall file any change to its Board membership with the Indiana Department of Education within thirty (30) days after the change occurs.
