The M.S.D. of Wayne Township no longer reports positive cases and quarantines to MCPHD and IDOH.

Visitors will be permitted to eat with students and staff during lunch after completing the required background screener in the school office. Hand sanitizer and sanitizing wipes will continue to be available.
